## House Rules

Residents must maintain complete abstinence from alcohol and illegal drugs at all times.

Residents must submit to random drug and alcohol testing when requested by house leadership.

Violence, threats, or aggressive behavior toward other residents or staff will not be tolerated.

Residents must respect quiet hours and maintain a peaceful living environment.

Residents are responsible for completing assigned household chores and maintaining cleanliness.

Residents must attend required house meetings and participate in recovery-supportive activities.

Curfew must be observed unless prior approval has been granted by the house manager.

Guests are not permitted inside the residence without approval from house leadership.

Residents must treat fellow residents, neighbors, and staff with respect and dignity.

Employment, job search activities, or participation in education or training programs is encouraged.

Any suspected relapse must be reported immediately to house leadership for appropriate action.

Residents must comply with all house policies and maintain behavior consistent with recovery living.
